 to the Conditions of an agreement  
 between the Village of Mt Union + himself  
 he was to receive a payment of \$250.00  
 on the Contract of Paving the public Square  
 in said Village when the brick was delivered  
 on the ground. As said brick was  
 on the ground he asked that an Order  
 be drawn on the Treasurer for the amount  
 of \$250.00.

On motion of Brick Second Jones the  
 Clerk was instructed to draw an Order  
 on the Treasurer in favor of John T. Antram  
 for \$250.00 Yeas Pennock Betts Bush  
 Jones Johnson Miller Seft Brick Yeas 8  
 Nays none

Jones Moved that the Solicitor be instructed to draw an Ordinance Authorizing the Mayor and Clerk of the City of Alliance to issue the Bonds of said City to the Amount of \$10000 for the purpose extending the time for payment of the Bonded Debt due Oct 1st 1888. Second by Johnson & Carried -

Petitions

A Petition was presented by Owners of land abutting on the Street the Northern Part of which is known as Mount Union Street and the Southern part as Portage Street asking that the Names of said Street be changed by Ordinance to "Union Avenue". An Ordinance was then Submitted Entitled And

Ordinance

To Change the Name of Mt Union and Portage Street to Union Avenue. Which Passed its first Reading.

Minutes of Council

On Motion of Betts Second by Jones the rules were suspended to permit the Ordinance to be read the Second. Yeas Pennock, Betts, Bush, Jones, Johnson, Miller. Seferit Vick Yeas 8 nays none

The Ordinance was read the Second time Jones Moved to suspend the rules. That the Ordinance pass its third reading, and put on its final passage, <sup>2nd by Bush & Carried</sup> Yeas Pennock Betts Bush Jones Johnson, Miller. Seferit Vick Yeas 8 nays none

The Ordinance was read the 3rd time and the vote on final passage stood as before Yeas 8 nays none.

The President declared the Ordinance duly passed.

Representative Clark of Mount Union Ward called the attention of the Council to <sup>the</sup> matter of appointing a proper person to take charge of the keys below of their Public Hall & Lockup. On Motion the ~~City~~ Mayor was instructed to take charge. On Motion of Johnson the Ex Mayor & Clerk of Mt Union Ward was requested to turn over said keys to Mayor Chapman. Seconded by Jones & Carreel.

### Street Rail Road Route

Mr Whitacre in behalf of the Alliance Street Railway Co. Reported the Route Selected by said Company as follows for their first line as follows. From the Union Depot on Main Street to Arch Street, thence South on Arch Street to Main Street Mount Union and thence West to the Center of Mt Union <sup>Ward</sup> Village. -- He also asked that the Council to proceed at once to do the necessary grading required on said Route. --

Representative Clark of Mt Union Ward Reported <sup>that</sup> the Job of Grading on Portage on Main Street in said ward was not completed in a satisfactory manner and that the same had not been accepted from the Contractor. On Motion referred to Street and Alley Committee.

### Second Reading.

An Ordinance Extending Water Mains and Locating Hydrants at Points therein Named

Vick moved to suspend the rules and that Ordinance be read the third time and put on its final passage seconded by Sefert. The yeas & nays called with the following result Yeas Betts, Miller Sefert, Vick. Nays Pennock Bush Jones Johnson. Yeas 4 Nays 4. The Motion was declared lost.

An Ordinance to provide for the pruning of shade trees overhanging the public walks.

Was read the second time. Bush moved to suspend the rules requiring Ordinances to be read on 3 different days that the Ordinance pass to its 3rd reading & final passage and Jones and carried yeas Pennock Betts Bush Jones Johnson Miller Sefert Vick Yeas 8 Nays none.
