Johnson Moved to Suspend the rules requiring Ordinances to be read on 3 different days. That the Ordinance be read the Second time. Seconded by Betts and Lost Yeas Pennock Betts Jones Johnson Miller Vick Williams Nays Bush Yeas 7 Nays 1 - The Motion was declared lost

The Committee to Whom was referred the Matter of Establishing a uniform distance for laying Sidewalks from the property lines. Reported in favor of About two feet

On Motion of Johnson referred to the Sidewalk Committee with instructions to report at the next Meeting by Ordinance

Wick Moved that the Clerk be instructed to publish Notice of the Petitions of P R Morgan Sr Henry Hess and L L Herr asking for the vacation of Certain Allies therein described. Second Second by Jones & Carried.

The Sidewalk Committee reported in favor of Continuing the grad on West Main Street in accordance with the Ordinance now in force - The Matter was referred to the Street Committee with instructions to Complete the work with as little damage to abutting property as possible.

Mayor Chapman reported that in consequence of the illness of Policeman Smetty had appointed Henry Grims as policeman in the Mount Union Ward.

Bush Moved that Mr Grims be retained on the police force until Mr Smetty was able to report for duty. Second by Johnson & Carried

Johnson Moved that the The Free fair Committee be granted the Use of the Streets for fair day and also All the Money Collected for licenses on said The Same to be issued by the Mayor ^{under the City Ordinance} and the Free fair Committee to pay all Expense for Extra Police Service on said day. Second by Betts and Carried.

Mr Vick moved that the Water Works Company be required to Move the Hydrant at the Corner of Cambridge and Arch Street to within the Curb line Secured by Johnson & Carreed

On Motion Vick Secured by Jones Mess Cassaday & Nichols was Appointed a Committee to represent the interest of Property Owners on Arch Street, Acting together with the Street Committee during the improving of Said Street - Carreed
