Mr Betts presented the Matter in regard to the disputed Curb lines on the West side of Park Street between Main Street and the Pittsburgh Foot ways & Chicago Rail Road and Moved that the Solicitor be instructed to legally notify A J Bergert Leo H Gant and B C Bates to vacate the Street back to their legal property lines. Second by Johnson Williams and Carried

Betts ^{then} Moved that the Side walks Committee be instructed to permit the present Side walks in course of construction ^{on the west side of} to be laid ^{of Park St} on the old walk line for the present. Second by Miller + Carried

Mr Vick in behalf of the grade Committee to whom was referred the Petition for Change of grade on Mechanic Street, reported adversely. - No further action

Johnson Moved that the Motion passed at the last meeting of Council instructing the Street Committee to purchase 18 inch tile for drainage across Arch Street be ~~reconsidered~~ reconsidered. Second by Jones and Carried. Johnson Moved that the same be referred back to the Street Committee with instructions to furnish such size tiling as they thought best. Second by Jones + Carried
