The Clerk Certified to the Council that Funds were in the hands of the Treasurer to the Amount of \$13,216 for the purpose of paying for the improve paving and improving Arch Street from Main Street South to Summit Street.

The Solicitor Submitted to the Council for their Approval which had been Approved and Signed by Nicholson & Co. Party of the Second Part The following
Contract

For the grading, draining, paving, curbing, guttering and the construction of cross walks on Arch Street from Main street south to North Curb of Summit street in the City of Alliance Ohio.

This agreement made & Entered into this 5th day of Nov. 1888. between the city Council of Alliance Ohio through its duly authorized agents in behalf of the city of Alliance and hereinafter known as the party of the first part, and Nicholson & Co. herein after known as the party of the second part.

Witnesseth that the party of the second part for & in consideration of the payments herein after mentioned and specified and agreed to be made up by the party of the first part hereby covenants & agrees to furnish and deliver all materials and do and perform all the work & labor required to be furnished and delivered, done and performed in and about the grading, draining, paving, curbing, guttering, & the construction of cross walks on Arch Street from Main

streets south to the north curb of Summit street in the city of Alliance Ohio. as authorized by ordinance approved and in strict and Entire conformity with the plans on file at the city clerk's office and in strict and Entire conformity with the specifications, a copy of which is hereunto annexed and which said plans and specifications are hereby made a part of this agreement as fully and with the same force and effect as if the same had been set forth at length in the body of this agreement.

The party of the second part further covenants and agrees that all of said materials shall be of the best of their several kinds and qualities and that all of said work and labor shall be done and performed in the best and most workman-like manner and that all of said materials, work and labor shall be subject to the inspection and approval of the city civil Engineer of the city of Alliance Ohio or his duly authorized assistant and the the city council and in case any of said materials or work shall be rejected by the said city civil Engineer or his assistant and the council as defective or unsuitable then the said material shall be removed and replaced by other materials and the said work shall be taken down and done over to the satisfaction and approval of said city civil Engineer or his assistant and the city council at the cost and expense of said party of the second part.

The party of the second part further covenants and agrees that all of said materials shall be furnished and delivered and all of said work and labor shall be done and performed to the satisfaction and approval of the said city civil Engineer and the city council on or before the first day of December 1888. And the party of the second part further agrees to do all work in a thorough and workman like manner and conform in every particular to the plans and directions of the committee in charge.

2nd To clean up and carry off from said streets all staves, earth, chips or other rubbish or material which may accumulate during the construction of said work.

In consideration of the premises the party of the first part hereby agrees to pay to the party of the second part the following prices, to wit:

Paving complete per sq. yd. including	\$.
Sand filling and top dressing	.93
Furnishing and laying curb complete	.26
per lineal foot	.26
Angle Blocks for curb corners - Each	.84
Iron Gutter Bridges per lb.	1 3/2
Excavation per cubic yard	.20
Ballast of Gravel and Sand foundation completed	.70

And it is mutually agreed by the parties hereto that said payment is to be made in the following manner^{2nd} upon the following stipulations, to wit; one third ($\frac{1}{3}$) when all material is on the ground; one third ($\frac{1}{3}$) when the paving is half done and the balance ten days after the the pavement is accepted by the city council.

And it is further mutually agreed by the parties hereto that all the measurements or determinations of quantities shall be made by the city civil Engineer or his duly authorized assistant^{2^d} that his measurements shall be final^{2^d} and conclusive between the parties and that nothing in this agreement contained shall be so construed as to deprive the said city of any remedy or defense it may have under the same for any violation of any of the terms or conditions of this agreement and the said city council shall have the right to require the party of the second part to suspend or discontinue the work or any part thereof when in the opinion of said city council the party of the second part is not doing the work in accord-

ance with the stipulations of this contract.

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Johnson Moved that the Street Commissioner be Authorized to required to Cut ditches on Each Side of South Garden Street Where grades had been done or Commenced Secured by Jones And Carried

On Motion the Street Commissioner Was instructed to repair pavement on West Main Street near Union Block-

Mr Betts. Reported to the Council the Amount of Work and Material furnished in Laying the Sidewalks on the Lumbor's property West Main Street. - Referred to Finance Committee.

Mayor Chapman Reported a Suspension of Sentence in the Kate Loftis Leguar Case had been Obtained in the Court of Common Pleas And that she having paid her fine of \$200. + Costs demanded that the same be paid back to her. - On Motion referred to Finance Committee with instructions to report at next meeting

Resolution

Resolved that the width of paving the Alleys on the Arch Street improvement be referred to the Committee on Streets and Alleys with power to Act in Connection with the City Engineer or his Assistant and with instructions to make Equitable terms with the paving Contractors and to have the Alleys paved to their full width on line of paving at their intersection with Arch Street.

Betts Moved the resolution be Adopted 2nd by Williams + Carried. Yeas Remock Betts Bush Jones Johnson. Miller Vick Williams Yeas 8 nays none
