Ordinances

To Vitalize Certain Alleys therein described passed Second reading. Jones moved to suspend the rules requiring Ordinance to be read on three different days that be read the 3rd time and put on final passage. Second by Betts and Carried Yeas Pennock Betts Bush Jones Johnson Miller Williams, Nays 8 yeas none.
 The Ordinance was read the third time and the vote on final passage stood as before yeas 8 nays none. The president declared the Ordinance duly passed.

Second Reading. An Ordinance to prevent the depacement of Property

An Ordinance

To Accept the dedication of Streets and Alleys in the Highland Park addition to the City of Alliance, was read the third time and on motion put on its final passage resulting Yeas Permoor Betts Bush Johnson Jones Miller Cook Williams Yeas 8 Nays none - The Ordinance was declared duly passed.

Johnson moved that the Solicitor Assist the Clerk to make out the Bills against the Arch Street property Owners abutting on said Arch Street improvement and the same be forwarded to the County Auditor to be placed on the tax duplicate. Motion Carried

Mr Johnson Chairman of the finance Committee reported a bill received from L A Godard Assistant Chief of the fire department for services rendered at the late fire. Referred to the Committee of the Fire Department.

Resolution

Mr Johnson offered the following Resolution
 Resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance
 O that it is not the intention of this Council of the City of Alliance to enter into any contract, agreement, or other obligations involving the expenditure of money or to pass any Ordinance resolution or order for the appropriation or expenditure of money, unless the Clerk of the said City of Alliance (there being no Auditor) shall first Certify that the money required for the contract agreement or other obligation or expenditure is in the Treasury to the credit of the Fund from which it is to be drawn and not appropriated for any other purpose and the same will not be done by the Council. And
 Resolved further that it is not the intent

of this Council or of the City of Alliance aforesaid to appropriate Money in its treasury for any purpose except by ^{an} Ordinance containing an explicit Statement of the uses and purposes for which the Appropriation is made and after the Clerk has certified of ^{the} said City of Alliance has certified that the Money so appropriated by such Ordinance is in the treasury to the credit of the fund or funds from which it is to be drawn and not appropriated for any other purpose and the same will not be done. And be it further Resolved, That it is not the intention of this Council of the City of Alliance aforesaid to pay, Comply with, or Execute, directly or indirectly any Claim presented against, or any Contract or Obligation entered into or order issued by the City of Alliance in violation of Sections 1693 and 5702 of the Revised Statutes of Ohio, and the same will not be done.
