Betts Moved that the Solicitor be instructed to draft an Ordinance Authorizing the Clerk to issue an Order in favor of J E Moore for the Sum of \$200. as a part payment on his Contract for grading main & Portage Streets in Mount Union Ward. Seconded by Jones and Carriest

Mr William in behalf of the Committee to Whom was referred recd the Petition of Citizens of Mt Union Ward asking for the removal of a tree from the Side Walk reported in favor of removing the same

On Motion report accepted

The Side Walk Committee to Whom was referred the petition of Citizens from the 6th Ward asking that the Side Walk between the Roins & Hasler Property be put to grade reported the same brought to grade leaving the Walk in worse Condition than before.

Bush Moved that the Solicitor draft an Ordinance ~~and~~ governing the Tramp Museum in accordance with the State Law Secured by Betts and Carried.

Mr Gamm addressed the Council by Calling their Attention to the damage done to his building the basement of his new building by an Overflow of water during heavy rains at the junction of Main and Arch Streets. and asked that the same be remedied without delay - On Motion referred to Street Committee with instruction to make a

full report of same at the next meeting. the motion prevailed

Solicitor Philips to whom was referred the Bill of the Board of health for cutting was reported as follows

Mr Nicholson of the firm of Nicholson & Co Arch Street improvement Contractors.

Asked for an extension of time to complete said improvement as the condition of the Street owing to continued rains was such as to render it impossible to make a satisfactory job. Whereupon the Mr Bush offered the following resolution.

Resolution to Extend the time within which the Contractors on the Arch Street improvement ^{are to} complete their Contract

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance that the time within which the Contractors on the Arch Street improvement are to complete their Contract be and the same is hereby extended at the said Contractors request to the 15th day of June 1889 provided that the said Contractors renew their Bond in a satisfactory manner, that will not themselves make any claim for damages or extra compensation against the said City in case the contemplated Street Rail way should in the mean while be constructed along the line of this improvement. Betts moved the adoption of the resolution seconded by Williams & Carried by
