Council met in regular session President

An Ordinance

Do Authorize the Alliance Street Railway Company
its Successors or Assigns, to Erect and Maintain poles
and wires in the streets alleys Avenues and Public
grounds of the City of Alliance, Ohio for certain
purposes therein stated. Was read the third
time. Johnson Moved that the word heat
be inserted in Section 1 after the word Electric
light so as to read. Electric light, heat and
power &c. Seconded by Betts and Carried
Yeas Perrin Betts Bush Jones Johnson Miller
Sefton Vick Williams. Yeas 9 Nays None

Betts Moved that the Ordinance as amended
be placed upon its final passage. Seconded
by Bush and Carried. A vote was then
taken the Yeas and Nays being called
on the final passage of the Ordinance
with the following result Yeas Perrin

Sefton Williams Vick - Yeas Nine
Nays None. The Ordinance was duly
duly Passed.

The Committee Reported as follows
 This C Whereas J R Morgan Sr has petitioned this Council for permission to place the necessary poles between the sidewalk and curb on Oxford Street for the purpose of supporting Electric Wires to enable him to light his dwelling house with Incandescent lights Therefore

On Motion the Mayor was authorized to renew ~~the~~ Contract for use of Telephone with Central Telephone Co

Mr Bush reported the need of a Plant

Found on South Arch Street near The State road. On Motion of ~~the~~ Representative Rice from Mt Union Ward was instructed to have the same put in

On Motion of Johnson the Clerk was instructed to report within two weeks the Amount of the floating indebtedness, showing the Amount each Fund had been Overdrawn.

The Fire Committee to whom was referred the Resignation of Elmer E. Clive as Chief of the Fire Department Reported in favor of Accepting the same.

Sept Moved the resignation be Accepted and that ~~Clive~~ ^{the} Assistant Chief have power to Act as Chief of the Fire Department until a Successor is Elected and that he be entitled to receive the same Salary as Chief.

Seconded by Betts and Carried

Johnson Moved that the Mayor be authorized to notify the Owners of Building lately destroyed by fire of their dangerous Condition of the walls - to have them torn down without delay. Seconded by Betts & Carried.

Solicitor Philip reported that the Bond of Nicholson & Co had been returned ~~the~~ with the Consent of the Sureties to the Extension of the time of Completing the Contract.
