On Motion referred to the Committee on Streets

 at its next meeting the names of Owners of  
 the lots and the value of the same, on  
 Union Avenue from Main Street Alliance to

To appropriate Money to pay certain Bills

Section 1 Be it Ordained by the Council of the City  
of Alliance  $\odot$  that there be and there is  
hereby appropriated as follows.

From the Arch Street Improvement Fund  
The sum of one hundred and twelve  $78/100$   
dollars to pay Nicholson Co. on account  
of extra labor and material performed and  
furnished thus far on the improvement of  
Arch Street.

From the Prison Fund the sum of nine  $4/100$   
dollars in favor of Chas Chapman  
for money advanced by him to pay claim  
of Cleveland Work House against the City  
of Alliance for Boarding prisoners.

From the Mount Union Fund the sum of twelve  
and  $66/100$  dollars to pay David Conrad for the  
lighting of 18 lamps @ 70c up to Nov 29<sup>th</sup> 1885

Also from the Mount Union Fund the sum of  
two  $34/100$  dollars to pay David Conrad for the  
cleaning of 18 Street Crossings @ 13<sup>cts</sup>

Also from Mt Union Road Fund the sum  
of two hundred dollars to apply on acc-  
ount of J. E. Moore against the city for work  
done under special contract for im-
