Council Chamber Alliance O Jan 14<sup>th</sup> 1889

Council met in regular Session

President M C Pennock presiding

Members present. Councilman Pennock Betts Bush Earley  
Johnson Miller, Vick, Williams. Representative Rice,  
Absent Councilmen. Jones. Defert - Representative Stanley

The Minutes of the last meeting was read  
and approved.

Mr Johnson Chairman of the Finance Committee Submitted  
and Ordinance for the payment of Bills, which was  
read as follows:

An Ordinance

To appropriate money in the City Treasury from the  
Funds and for the purposes therein specified.

Section 1 Be it Ordained by the Council of the City of Alliance O  
that there be and there is hereby appropriated from  
available moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropri-  
ated from the funds and for the purpose the sums  
as follows to wit:

A Petition was presented by J W Crane  
 Rep. Signed by Owners of Property On West Main Street Protesting  
 Against the Council using its influence to have the West Corpo-  
 ration line road vacated at the Rail Road Crossing as asked  
 for by the Rail Road Company.

On Motion refer to the Committee on Street and Alleys

Mr Vick in behalf of the gas Committee to was referred  
 the petition for the removal of Street Lamp from the  
 Corner of Oxford & Liberty Streets to a point near the Welch  
 Church. Reported the same had been done, to the satisfaction  
 of the Council.

Representative Rice Reported to the  
 Council that a culvert on South Liberty Street was in  
 a dangerous condition. Betts Moved that the Clerk be  
 instructed to notify the Township Trustees of the same  
 that they might notify the County Commissioners.  
 Carried

Bush Moved that J W Gillespie be granted Permission  
 to Erect an Outside Stair way on East Side of his  
 building on Main Street said Stair way not to exceed 32  
 inches in width. Second by Vick And Carried.

Third Reading An Ordinance to Improve  
 Arch Street from Main Street in Mount Union Ward  
 North to Summit Street. And Motion Vick Second  
 Johnson a vote was taken on the final passage Resulting  
 Yeas Pennock Betts Bush Johnson Miller Vick Williams  
 Yeas 7 nays none The Ordinance was declared duly Passed

First Reading An Ordinance To Authorize the Mayor  
 and Clerk of the City of Alliance Ohio to issue the Bonds  
 of said City for the purpose of extending the time  
 of payment of the Bonded debt due of said City  
 due Feb 1<sup>st</sup> 1889.

On Motion of Johnson Second  
 by Miller President Pennock was authorized to nego-  
 tiate to the best advantage for funds to meet the  
 Bonds falling due until the same could be realized  
 from the sale of Bonds for refunding the amount
