A Communication from the President of the Alliance
 Street Railway Company was received and read asking
 permission to make a bid for lighting the streets
 with Electricity.

Betts Moved that the Light Committee
 be instructed to take into consideration the propriety
 of lighting the City with Electricity and to report
 to the Council what number of lights are required
 and at what points they should be placed.
 Seconded by Earley and Carried

The Ordinance to Prevent the Obstruction
 of Sidewalks with Snow Slush or ice was called
 up for final passage.

Jones Moved to Amend by striking out the
 words ~~snow or ice~~ ^{slush}, also changing the penalty
 from twenty five dollars ~~to~~ \$5.00 - to substitute
 the word "Occupied" instead of "Owned." - Also
 that notices be served by the Marshal instead of Street
 Commissioner &c. - Seconded by Betts & Carried -

The Ordinance was then read as amended
 and on motion submitted to a vote on its
 final passage with the following result
 Yeas Jones Vick Bush - Nays Pennock, Betts
 Johnson Miller Earley Williams
 Yeas 3 Nays 6 - The passage of the ordinance
 was declared lost

An Ordinance

To appropriate money in the City Treasury
 for the purpose therein stated

Section Be it Ordained and Enacted by the Council of the City of Alliance Ohio that there be and there is hereby appropriated from any money in the Treasury to the credit of the Road Fund of Mount Union Ward and not otherwise appropriated the sum of thirty three and 10/100 Dollars to pay the bill of J. E. Moore for grading Main Street in Mt Union Ward in accordance with the Special Contract for the same and in full of the amount due under said Contract and the Clerk is authorized to draw his warrant for the same on the receipt of proper vouchers.
