Communications

From The Alliance Street Railway Company was read as follows:

To the Honorable Council of the City of Alliance O

The Alliance Street Railway Co would ask permission of your honorable body to place their Incandescent System of Lighting in the Council Rooms for the purpose lighting the same at our expense and will remove them whenever so desired by the Council

Johnson moved that the proposition of Alliance St Rail Way Co be accepted seconded by Betts and carried:

Petitions

A Petition was presented to Council signed ^{owners of} by ~~by~~ ^{over} two thirds of feet front of Property Abutting on Liberty Street from Main Street to Summit Asking for the Improvement of said Liberty Street between said points by grading & paving with fire brick or other suitable material &c - Referred to Street Committee & Solicitor

Petitions from Citizens of the Mt Union Wards asking that the names of certain streets be changed, as follows

That West Liberty Street in said ward be changed from West Liberty to Cherry Street

That Portage Street in 1st Union Ward be Changed from Portage to Union Avenue. Also that the name of Walnut Street in said Ward be Changed to Hartshorn Street and Euclid Street to Miller Avenue.

On Motion refer to Street Committee

Petition

Signed by about 75 qualified Electors residing in the First Ward asking that the place for voting in said Ward be Changed from its present location to some place on Main Street within the limits of the ward. Resolved that the petition be referred to the Building Committee with instruction to select suitable voting places for each Ward for the coming Election. And report the same to the Council at their next meeting. Secured ~~John~~ Dick and Carver

Petition to Improve Arch Street between Summit and Mulner Street. Signed by the owners of more than 2/3 of the property abutting on the same asking for the improvement of Arch Street between said points by grading the same and paving with the road bed with fire brick, block or other material deemed proper for a distance not to exceed 28 feet in width.

On Motion referred to Street Committee

Street Commissioner White submitted a report showing that 103 had paid Poll Tax which was on motion referred to Finance Committee

Bells moved that the Finance Committee be instructed to confer with the Solicitor and draft an act to be presented to the legislature for their passage providing that the expense of grading and paving on all streets be assessed on the property abutting on said streets. Secured by Miller and Carver.
