Council Met in regular Session

President M C Pennock in the Chair

On Motion the reading of the minutes of last meeting
was dispensed with.

Ordinances

Called up for third Reading. An Ordinance
Entitled An Ordinance &

To Authorize the Mayor and Clerk to issue
the Bonds of the City of Alliance O for the Sum of
of Thirteen Thousand Five Hundred Dollars for the
purpose of paying the present floating debt of
said City and to Levy a Tax for the purpose of
paying the principal and interest of the same.
Johnson Moved the Ordinance be referred to a Committee
of One to Amend. Carried.

The Ordinance was Amended to read Fourteen Thousand
Dollars instead of Thirteen Thousand Five Hundred
Dollars. And read the third time as Amended
Johnson Moved the Ordinance be put on its final
passage as Amended and read the third time
Second by Betts + Carried.

A vote was then taken on the final passage of the
Ordinance as Amended. With the following result
