To Improve Union Avenue between Main Street
And State Street in the City of Alliance

Resolved that in the
Opinion of two thirds of the members elected to the Council of the City
of Alliance Ohio it is necessary to improve Union Avenue, from
Main Street to State Street in Said City by grading, draining
Macadamizing and Street Crossing (such improvement being
recommended by the St. Committee in Accordance plans
profiles and Specifications on file with Said Street Com-
tee. The Expense of Said improvement to be assessed
per foot front on the property bounding and abutting
thereon Except as otherwise provided by law, the assessments
therefor to be payable in five Annual Installments if deferred
And the same Collected as provided by law and in
the Assessing Ordinance hereinafter to be passed
Bonds May be issued in Anticipation of the Collection
of the Assessments unless the property Owners pay their
Assessments before the same are issued and within
the time prescribed in Said Assessing Ordinance, and
the Clerk is hereby directed to Cause this resolution
to be published in a newspaper of general Circulation
in the Corporation for a period of two Consecutive weeks

To Whom was referred the petition of Celerus Living on And in proximity to Hester Avenue. Reported As follows - We the Committee to Whom was referred the petition from Celerus on Hester Avenue Asking for a Suitable Crossing over the Stream running North and Crossing this Street near the Union School House recommend Stone Abutment And bridge Complete, Suitable for Wagon and foot Pedestrians.

Mr Williams offered the following Resolution
Whereas the Bricks being furnished for the paving of Arch Street are not of such quality as the Specifications for the work requires, nor of such quality as the same submitted to Council previous to entering into the paving Contract And
Whereas the Condition of the brick

on the ground and of the pavement already laid show that if used they will prove a failure. Therefore be it Resolved That this Council will not approve or accept Any Paving now laid or yet to be laid under the present Contract where such material is used.

Resolved that a copy of these resolutions be served by the Clerk of this City on the Contractors of the Arch Street improvement.

On motion the Clerk was instructed to advertise for bids for lighting the City with Electricity in accordance with the report of the Committee on Electric light - Carried

Offered By Mr. Bush the following Resolution

Declaring it necessary to improve Liberty Street from Main Street South to Summit Street.

Resolved that in the Opinion of two thirds of the Members Elected to the Council of the City of Alliance, Ohio, it is necessary to improve Liberty Street from Main Street South to Summit Street by grading the same, paving the road bed with fire bricks or other suitable material for a distance of at least thirty feet in width setting curb and gutter stones and constructing the necessary Culverts and drains, (Such improvements being recommended by this Street Committee) in accordance with the profiles and specifications to be filed in the office of the City Clerk the Expense of Said improvement to be assessed per foot upon the property bounding and abutting thereon according to the law and Ordinance in the subject of Assessments; the Assessments therefor to be payable in five annual installments if deferred and the same collected as provided by law and the Assessing Ordinance hereafter to be passed.

Bonds may be issued in anticipation of the Collection of the Assessment unless the property owners pay their Assessments before the same are issued and within the time prescribed by in said

Assessing Ordinance, and the Clerk is hereby directed to Cause this resolution to be published in A Newspaper of general Circulation in the Corporation for a period of two Consecutive Weeks.
