From Citizens on South Liberty Street asking  
the Council to consider the ~~the~~ unsafe condition  
of the South End of said Street  
referred to Street Committee

Offered by Mr Betts the following Resolution

Declarins it Necessary to Improve Market

Street from Arch Street to Liberty Street

Resolved that in the Opinion of two thirds of the Members  
Elected to the Council of the City of Alliance Ohio it  
is necessary to improve Market Street from Arch  
Street to Liberty Street by grading paving with fire  
brick or suitable Material, setting Curbstones and Constr-  
ucting the necessary drains Culverts and Cross walks  
(Such improvement being recommended by the Street  
Committee of Council) in accordance with Specific-  
ations on file with said Street Committee

The Expense of said Improvement to be assessed per  
front foot upon the property bounding and abutting  
there on according to the law and Ordinance on the  
the Subject of Assessments; The Assessments therefor  
to be payable in Five Annual Installments if deferred and  
and the same collected as provided by law and in the  
Assessing Ordinance here after to be passed.

Bonds may be issued in Anticipation of the Collection  
of the Assessments unless the property Owners pay  
their Assessments before the same are issued and  
within the time prescribed in said assessing Ordinance  
and the Clerk is hereby directed to cause this resolu-  
tion to be published in a Newspaper of general or  
general Circulation in the Corporation for

a period of two consecutive weeks.

Passed thro 8<sup>th</sup> day of April 1889.

the Board of health for the year ending May 1<sup>st</sup> 1889  
(A large amount of work has been done and much  
left undone for the want of money. Our death  
rate has been higher and unless there is sewers  
put down to carry off the surface filth our percent  
of death will not be less. And it is the wish of  
this Board the Honorable Council take action as  
soon as possible to commence some system  
of sewerage. We ask for the appropriation of  
a certain sum of money to be placed in the hands  
of James Seal Subject, to the Order of the Board of  
health.
