Council met in adjourned session with vice President Hull in chair. Members present Bush. Earley. Siefert. Miller. Hull. Hartzell. Johnson. Brinker. Braine. Crumbaugh. Absent: Penrock and Betts. The committee to whom was referred the question of vacating. Portion of Patterson St and the Rockhill road. reported favorably upon the vacation of that part of Patterson Street mentioned in the resolution. and upon the vacation of the Rockhill Road on condition that the R.R. Co Erect and Maintain a suitable wagon and foot bridge. at some point farther East. Moved by Johnson and seconded by Hartzell that the report be adopted. after addresses by A. B. Starr and a number of others the yeas & nays were called. resulting as follows

(Yeas) Bush Siefert Miller Hartzell Johnson Braine Crumbaugh Hull. (Yeas) Earley. Brinker. Yeas (2) nays (8)

Motion declared lost, on Motion of Braine the vote was reconsidered and that part of the report vacating Patterson Street. was adopted by unanimous vote. and that relating to the vacation of the Rockhill road. was lost. The vote being the same as upon the adoption of the committee's report. Bush then offered the following.

Be it resolved that it is the sense of this Council that we vacate that portion of the Rockhill Road from the north side of the Penna. Co's right of way to the south side of same right of way
