The Committee to whom was referred the matter
of investigating the arch street paving
made the following report

To the city Council of Alliance Ohio. Gentlemen
Your committee to whom was referred the matter of
arch street paving brick would respectfully submit the
following report all the members being present and concurring
1st we would require that all the pavement now laid be
taken up. 2nd The contractors should have all
the brick carefully inspected at their own expense
before they are laid and such as are of doubtful
quality rejected. 3^d We are of the opinion
that no special brand or make of paving brick
should be rejected provided that a bond of
indemnity in the amount of \$50000⁰⁰ be given
to the entire satisfaction of the council conditional
that all loss, damage, or defects appearing in the pavement
and resulting from the use of inferior quality or
defective bricks will at once be made good, and
that the City and abutting property owners shall
be at ^{no} cost or expense whatever in making good
any such defect or damage for the period of five
years after the pavement is laid.
