

Council Chamber Alliance 8 June 10 1889

Council met in adjourned session with Vice President Hull in the Chair and the following members present: Bush, Earley, Miller, Hartzell, Johnson, Brinker, Scrubbaugh.

Communications.

A communication from Property owners on Broadway between C & P R R and Webb St. asking for the improvement of said street by paving was read and on motion of Johnson was referred to Street committee.

Bills for the month of May was read and on motion of Brinker the solicitor was instructed to prepare an ordinance for the payment of same.

The bill of Oby & Love having been referred to the Lighting committee.

Johnson moved that the sum of \$130<sup>00</sup> be appropriated to the general fund from the unappropriated fund. To apply on the bill of H. A. Deel <sup>Pres</sup> as Treasurer. Sec by Hartzell

The Yeas & Nays being called resulted: Yeas 8 Nays 0

President Remock entered the room at this time and occupied the Chair.

Johnson of the finance committee reported the following apportionment of funds realized from the sale of floating debt bonds.

The report of the Marshal of having served notice on property owners on Arch Street between Summit Street and Milner Street of Passage by Council of resolution declaring it necessary to improve said street was read

An Ordinance. entitled "an ordinance To apportion among the various funds of the city certain moneys now unapportioned in the City Treasury". Was read. And on motion of Johnson seconded by Brinker the same was put upon its passage.

The yeas & Nays being called resulted: Yeas (9) Nays (0). and was declared carried

An Ordinance entitled

Passage of Ordinance to improve South Arch st

An Ordinance to improve Arch Street from Summit Street south to Milner Street was read. Bush moved the rules be suspended and the ordinance be read second time by its title. Seconded by Hartzell.

The yeas & Nays being called resulted Yeas 9. Nays 0 and motion declared carried

The ordinance was then read 2<sup>nd</sup> time by title  
Moved by Johnson seconded by

Brinker that rules be suspended and ordinance read third time. yeas and nays being called resulting yeas (9) nays (0)

The ordinance <sup>read third ~~time~~</sup> was then put upon its final passage. and the yeas and nays called which resulted yeas 9 nays 0 and President Pennock declared the ordinance duly passed. Hartzell moved that A Hatcher and R. E. Hudson be appointed a

committee to act with engineer in the above improvement. Yeas & Nays called. resulting. Yeas 9 nays 0. and the motion declared carried.

on motion of Bush sec by Brinker the Engineer was instructed to prepare plans and specifications for the improvement of Arch Street. Moved by Brinker and

to prepare ordinance for improvement of Market St

seconded by Bush that the solicitor be instructed to prepare an ordinance for the improvement of Market Street. Carried.

Bush moved that Wm Speaker and L Dodding be appointed as committee to act with the engineer in the improvement of Market Street. Yeas sec by Johnson

The yeas and Nays were called and resulted  
Yeas 9 Nays 0. Motion declared carried.

on Motion of Bush sec by Brinker The Engineer  
was instructed to prepare plans and specifications  
for the improvement of Market Street

The Street Committee to whom was referred  
The communication from property owners  
on Broadway. Reported favorably on the same  
and on Motion of Johnson sec by Hull The  
report was adopted.

#### Resolution.

Bush offered the following resolution and  
moved its adoption. "Be it resolved that it  
is the sense of this Council that it is  
necessary to improve Broadway street as  
Petitioned by the property owners on said street,"  
Seconded by Johnson and carried,

Bush moved that W<sup>m</sup>. Edwards and  
T. R. Morgan Sr. be appointed a committee to  
act with the engineer in the improvement  
of Broadway, sec by Miller. Yeas and Nays  
called, and resulted, Yeas 9 Nays 0.

On Motion of Bush Seconded  
by Brinker The Marshal was instructed  
to notify property owners on Broadway of  
the proposed improvement.

On Motion of Brinker seconded by  
Bush. The engineer was instructed to  
prepare Plans and specifications  
for the improvement of Broadway.

The mayor reported the necessity of  
more hitching Posts. for the accommodations of  
people coming to the city with teams, and on  
motion of Bush the same was referred to  
Committee on buildings and grounds

#### An Ordinance, Entitled

An Ordinance to appropriate money in the City  
Treasury for the purposes of paying the  
floating debt against the City."

Was read. Moved by Johnson Sec by  
Johnson The same be placed on its final  
Passage The yeas & Nays called resulted yeas 9 Nays 0

Brinker moved that the engineer report at next meeting in regard to grade on Oxford St seconded by Johnson and carried.

passage of ordinance to levy a tax of one mill  
 An Ordinance to levy a tax of one mill for the purpose of paying interest and principal on floating debt Bonds was read and on motion of Bush seconded by Brinker The same was put on its final passage The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas 9 nays 0

Committee to confer with R.R. Engineers for Oxford St crossing  
 Brinker moved that a committee be appointed to confer with Railroad engineer in regard to Street crossing on Oxford Street seconded by Bush and carried

Messrs Brinker, Bush and Johnson were then appointed as the above committee

Cornbaugh reported that a portion of South Arch Street near State Street was in bad condition in consequence of no outlet for water and on motion of Johnson the same was referred to the Street Committee with power to act

Bush then offered the following resolutions and moved its adoption

G. H. Funk  
 Be it resolved that it is the sense of this council that the condition of the property belonging to G. H. Funk is a nuisance and dangerous to the public health and that the same be abated within three days after legal notice has been given

seconded by Hartzell and carried -
