The Judiciary Committee to whom ~~was~~

referred report the following propositions

1st That the amount of money necessary to pay the
present contractor Thos Bevington for all work
actually done by himself in grading Arch Street
should be assessed on all property between
Summit Street and State Street excepting the 2%
as is otherwise provided by Statute

2nd That no money used or expended in grading
an Arch Street except as stated in the first
proposition can be assessed on any property.

3rd That the property on Arch Street between
Summit Street and Milner Street can be assessed
for grading Arch Street between Summit Street
and State Street and also for paving between
Summit Street and Milner Street and the only
way this Committee can see how the property
owners between Summit and Milner Streets
can be relieved from a double assessment
would be for the city to assume and pay such an
amount of said paving as would equal the amount
of their assessments for grading Arch St
