Council met in adjourned session with president Remock presiding and the following members present.

Bush. Carley. Miller Hartzell Johnson Brinker. Absent. Betts Defert. Hull Coaine and Corubaugh. on motion of Johnson the reading of the Minutes of preceding Meeting was omitted.

The reading of bids for Electric Light was called for and were read as follows.

Bid of Alliance Street Railway Co. for ~~40~~³⁰ or more Lights to burn until midnight each night during the year. six (6) Dollars per Lamp per month.

The Mutual Electric Light Co for Main Street and all other lights wanted on the north side of P. D. W. R. R. six (6) dollars per Lamp per month.

On motion of Johnson the same were referred to the lighting committee.

On Motion of Bush Seconded by Hartzell. The Solicitor was instructed to prepare an ordinance assessing the Alliance Street Railway Co for their of the Excavating filling and paving of Arch Street between Summit and Miller Streets.

An Ordinance to Amend section 2 of an Ordinance. entitled "an Ordinance to authorize the Mayor and Clerk of the city of Alliance Ohio to issue the bonds of said city for the purpose of extending time of payment of the bonded debt of said city. now due and coming due Aug 2 and September 2nd 1889" Passed Aug 5, 1889 was read first time.
