Resolution to regulate speed of St Cars

Be it resolved that it is the sense of this Council that any Street cars running within the city limits shall not be allowed to run at a higher rate of speed than six (6) miles per hour and that any operator or driver of such cars violating the ordinances regulating the speed of Street R. W. cars shall be fined not

less than five dollars for each and every
offense and that the city solicitor be
instructed to prepare an ordinance to conform
to the above resolution. and moved its
adoption. seconded by Hull and carried

Croubough Penrock. Ymas 7 nays none.
