The attention of Council was called to the intrusion of R.R. Co on private property in Freedom and on Motion of Brinker Sec by Bush. The matter was referred to the Solicitor and Engineer.

The report of the Engineer certifying that more than two thirds  $\frac{2}{3}$  of the work of improving Union Avenue had been done by Mr Mcleanley was read and on motion of Betts the same was accepted and ordered placed on file.

Know all men by these presents. That we Shaffer & Rue as principals and Joseph Kelley as Sureties are held and bound <sup>unto</sup> ~~under~~ the City of Alliance in the sum of Two Thousand (2000) Dollars for the payment of which well and truly to be made we do hereby bind ourselves signed this 28<sup>th</sup> day of October 1890

The condition of ~~this bond~~ the above obligations is such that whereas, Shaffer & Rue have guaranteed and do hereby guarantee to the city of Alliance aforesaid the fire clay paving brick used by the said Shaffer & Rue in the paving of Broad street from the C & P R.R. to the west side of South Crest Street to be first class fire paving brick and the said Shaffer & Rue do hereby furthermore agree to indemnify the said City of Alliance against any and all loss arising from the use of said brick for a period of five years from and after the completion of ~~said~~ the contract and for the same period of five years said Shaffer & Rue agree to replace from time to time at their own expense and without unnecessary delay all brick injured in said paving as the result of traffic or weather and to keep and have the brick used in said pavement.

(Natural wear and tear alone excepted) as good at the end of the said period of five years as at the beginning. Now if the said Shaffer & Rue shall faithfully perform and do the several matters and things above mentioned during the period aforesaid then the obligation shall be void. otherwise it shall be and remain in full force and virtue in law.

A number of bills against the city for the month of October were read and on motion of Brinker the solicitor was instructed to prepare an ordinance for their payment.
