

Council Chamber. Alliance O Nov 28 1889

Council met in Special Session upon call of Mayor Chapman for the purpose of making settlement with the Liberty Street and Broadway contractors for the improvement of said streets with president Penwick presiding and the following members present. Betts Bush Miller Hull Brinker Crumbaugh. Absent. Carley. Sept. Hartzell Johnson Coraine.

The report of Street Committee on the Liberty Street improvement. being called for. Mr Bush stated that they were not ready to report as they did not consider the work completed according to the specifications. and moved that there be paid Davis & Caldwell contractors the sum of Three Thousand dollars seconded by Brinker and carried. Moved by Brinker seconded by Bush

there be paid Shaffer & Rue the sum of ~~the~~ Twelve Hundred dollars (1200) carried. Moved by Brinker and seconded the Solicitor. be instructed to prepare Ordinance providing for the payment of the above amounts carried.

The following Ordinance was then read as follows  
An Ordinance

To appropriate money in the city treasury for the purpose of paying certain claims herein specified

Sec 1. Be it ordained by the council of the city of Alliance that there be and there hereby is appropriated from any money in the city treasury not otherwise appropriated to the credit of the various funds hereinafter designated the amounts specified and for the purposes as follows

From the Liberty Street improvement fund  
To Davis & Caldwell contractors for the Liberty Street improvement on second estimate of the city civil engineer \$3000<sup>00</sup>

From the Union Avenue improvement fund  
From the Broadway Street improvement fund  
To Shaffer & Rue contractors. for Broad Street improvement
