

Council Chamber. Alliance O Dec 16/89
 Council met in regular session with President
 Penrock presiding and the following Members
 present. Bush Miller Hull Brinker Craine
 Kernbaugh Absent. Betts. Earley. Siefert Starzell
 Johnson. Minutes of preceding meetings read
 and approved.

A communication from the cemetery trustees asking
 that the salary of the cemetery clerk be increased
 from thirty dollars per year to seventy five dollars
 per year was read and on Motion of Brinker
 was referred to the Judiciary Committee.

A Petition
 signed by property owners on Main Street between
 Mechanic and Street and Union Avenue asking that
 said portion of Street be improved by paving with
 brick. was read and on Motion of Craine was
 referred to Street Committee.
