Whereas it appears that many property owners taxed for such improvements have understood that the first assessment for the purpose would not be collected until June and so have not prepared to pay it at this time. Therefore be it resolved that the County Auditor be and the same is hereby requested through the Clerk of the city to charge up on the tax duplicate for collection with the last half of the taxes in June next all such special assessment against the property on the streets above specified remaining unpaid at this time.
