

Council Chamber Alliance O. Dec 30 1889.

Council met in special session upon call of the Mayor for the purpose of completing arrangements for lighting the city with electricity.

President Remock presiding and the following members present. Betts Bush Early Miller Hull Hartzell. Brinker Crubough.

Motion

Moved by Brinker seconded by Hull that the vote on the acceptance of the bid of the Alliance Street Railway Co for lighting the city with electricity be reconsidered. Carried: Yeas. Bush Hull Hartzell Brinker Crubough Remock. Nays. Betts Early Miller yeas 6 nays 3.

Motion

Moved by Brinker that the Mutual Electric Light Co be accepted seconded by Hartzell and lost.

Yeas Miller Hull Hartzell Brinker Crubough Nays. Betts Bush Early Remock. Yeas 5 Nays 4.

Moved by Bush seconded by Remock the vote on the acceptance of the bid of the Mutual Electric Light Co be reconsidered.

Carried. Yeas Bush. Miller. Hull. Hartzell.

Brinker. Crubough. Remock. Yeas 7. Nays none. Messrs Betts and Early having retired.

~~Proposition~~. The bids of the Alliance Street Railway Co and Mutual Electric Light Co. having been read. Mr H. S. Whitacre representing the Alliance Street Railway Co being present. submitted the following. "We hereby change our bid so as to include all lights south of Main Street and relinquish that part covering Main Street and that part of the city north of Main Street."

The Alliance Street Railway Co. Brinker made the following motion. That we accept the bid of the Mutual Electric Light Co. for Main Street. and the first and second wards also accept the bid of the Alliance Street Railway Co for all the lights for the third, fourth, fifth and sixth wards. Provided that each company enter into a contract within ten days and

a satisfactory bond. Seconded by Startzell and The yeas and nays called resulting yeas Bush. Miller Hull Brinker Startzell Lambough Pennock. Yeas 7 nays none. and the motion was declared carried.

Moved by Miller and second by Bush that the Light-Committee. ~~not~~ and the councilmen in each ward. be authorized to locate the lights in each Ward. Carried.

Bush. Then offered the following resolution Be it resolved that it is the sense of this council that the two companies whose bids have been accepted proceed at once to furnish lights as soon as the light committee may direct the location; and moved its adoption. Seconded by Brinker. Yeas and nays called resulting yeas. Bush Miller Startzell Brinker Lambough Nays Hull. Pennock. Yeas 5 nays 2 and the Motion was declared lost.

Moved by Brinker seconded by Bush Council proceed at once to locate lights on Main Street. carried.

Moved by Brinker Sec by Miller that the Light at the intersection of Main and Park Streets be Moved to west Main Street to some point west of the hollow at Lambon's Carried.

Moved by Miller seconded by Bush that the balance of the lights on Main Street be left as they now are. Carried.
