or other suitable material for a distance of not less than twenty eight (28) feet in width setting curb and gutter stones and constructing the necessary drains and culverts. (Such improvement being recommended by the Street committee of Council) in accordance with profiles and specifications to be placed on file in the office of the city clerk. The expense of said improvement to be assessed per foot front upon the property bounding and abutting thereon according to the law and on the subject of assessments.

The assessments therefor to be payable in five annual installments if deferred and the same collected as provided by law and the assessing ordinance hereafter to be passed.

Bonds may be issued in anticipation of the collection of the assessments unless the property owners pay their assessments before the same are issued and within the time prescribed in said assessing ordinance. and the clerk is hereby directed to cause this resolution to be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the corporation for a period of two consecutive weeks.

Report of Police Com

The police committee at this time recommended that there be employed for the coming year. two policemen at \$50.00 per month and one policeman at the same rate to serve half time. and that two Extra policemen be sworn in each ward of the city to act when called upon. and the regularly appointed police to uniform at their own expense.
