On Motion of Bush seconded by Hartzell The Solicitor was instructed to prepare an Ordinance requiring Teamsters to keep end gates on their wagons. To prevent dirt from falling off on the streets.

Moved by Brinker The Engineer set grade stakes for A. H. Coates on Union Avenue and give grade on S. E. corner Liberty and Summit Streets and also at Davidson lot on Columbia street. The yeas and nays were called on the motion resulting Yeas Brinker Bush Cowan Brubough Hartzell Kynett Keplinger McLaughlin Wilson Hull. Yeas 10 Nays none and the Motion was declared carried.

Mayor Stillwell at this time presented the name of Geo. R. Gyger for City Civil Engineer for the ensuing year.

all cross streets and alleys where  
property owners have placed curb stones  
or Layed stone or brick sidewalks to  
grade. Said Street crossings to be of  
Warren flag stone four inches thick  
and four feet wide and to be layed  
to curb grade. Sidewalks to be to grade

Keplinger seconded the motion  
to adopt. The yeas and nays were called  
resulting Yeas Brinker Bush Cowan  
Kynett Keplinger McLaughlin  
Wilson Hull. Yeas 8 Nays none and  
the resolution was declared adopted

 Also the correct numbers and additions  
 of lots, or description of lands, churches, or  
 Public grounds, and per foot front of Seneca.

Keplinger seconded the motion to  
 adopt. The Yeas and Nays were called resulting  
 Yeas Brinker Bush Crumbaugh Kynett  
 Keplinger McLaughlin Wilson Hull.  
 Yeas 8 nays none. and the resolution was  
 declared adopted.

 Disciple Church property, consisting of  
 Brinker Hull & Crumbaugh, appraise  
 the unplatted lands on Main Street on  
 the line of the proposed improvements.

Solicitor

 valuation  
 of lots

Moved by Brinker seconded by Keplinger,  
 that the Solicitor furnish Council with  
 the valuation of all lots and lands on  
 Main Street from Mechanic to corporation  
 line. On Oxford Street from Morgan to  
 Seneca and from Arch to Union Square  
 and on Seneca Street from Main to  
 Summit. The Yeas and Nays were called resulting  
 Yeas Brinker Bush Crumbaugh Kynett Keplinger  
 McLaughlin Wilson Hull. Yeas 8 Nays none.  
 and the motion was declared carried.
