

Council Chamber Alliance this May 19. 1890

Council met in regular session with President Hull in the chair and the following Members present. Brinker Bush Crubaugh Hartzell Kynett Keplinger. McLaughlin and Wilson. Absent Carley Isfert. Cowan

The minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Report of
cemetery committee

The Cemetery committee reported that a number of bodies were being removed from the cemetery in the 6th ward and the graves were not being filled properly. Some of them being left in a dangerous condition. and recommended some action by council in regard to the matter. On motion of Brinker

The same was referred to the cemetery committee with power to act.
