With President Hull presiding and the
following members present. Brinker Bush
Cowan Carley Hartzell Keplinger
McLaughlin Wilson. Absent Crubough
Kynett. Defert. There not being
sufficient money in certain funds
to pay the appropriations called for
in the bills ordinance. Brinker
moved that there be apportioned from
the unapportioned fund to the
general fund \$2500 and to the Street
and Sanitary fund \$1250. seconded by
