

Council Chamber Alliance O June 28/90

Council met in Special Session. in response to the following Notice.

"You are hereby notified that a Special Meeting of the Alliance City Council is called to convene at the Council Chamber - in said City on Saturday Evening. June 28 1890 at 7.30 p M to act upon the West Main Street assessing Ordinance and to take action on the Ordinance to improve West Main Street from Union Avenue to the Corporation line.

To Amend the Grade on Oxford Street between Liberty and Morgan Streets also to consider the petition for the improvement of North Webb Street."

President Hull being absent Vice pres Wilson presided. The roll called and the following Members present - Brinker Bush. Cowan Cornbough Keplinger McLaughlin. Hartzell.

A Petition of more than two thirds of the property owners on North Webb Street from the P F W & C R W to the North Corporation line petitioning for the improvement of said Webb Street between the above points by Macadamizing the same for a distance of not less than 20 feet in width.

Setting curb and gutter stones. and constructing the necessary culverts and drains was read. and on Motion of Brinker seconded by Hartzell was referred to the Street Committee.

An Ordinance Entitled An Ordinance to authorize the improvement of Main Street from Union Avenue West to the Corporation line was read first time.
