To The City Council Alliance This year committee to whom was referred the matter of the west Main street paving would respectfully report that that it is the desire of the petitioners that river brick or some other brand as acceptable to the committee be used. That the pitch and gutter bridges be dispensed with and that but two catch basins be put in. We find W. H. Gilson's bid to be the lowest for the work to be done and recommend that the contract be awarded to him.

He had decided that the Canton Brick stood the test to the best satisfaction and reported the sense of the committee that the contractor for the paving of Oxford Street be required to use the Canton Brick Co's brick. and moved the adoption of the report seconded by Brinker and carried.
