Bush of the Street committee reported

The Cemetery Committee

made the following report. "Our Committee to

 to purchase more land suitable to enlarge

 acres west of and adjoining the Cemetery.  
 We find the 15 acres above mentioned can be  
 bought from Mr Peters for \$3500<sup>00</sup> by paying  
 \$1000 cash at time of purchase. We can have  
 our own time to pay the balance by giving  
 bond at 6% interest. Mr Peters agrees to  
 receive installments on the bond of two hundred  
 dollars or more at any time we have a surplus
