Be it resolved by the council of the city of Alliance Ohio that it is hereby declared necessary to improve Patterson Street from the Cleveland & Pittsburgh R.R. East to the corporation line by putting the same to the established grade. Macadamizing the roadbed with furnace slag and constructing the necessary drains and culverts in accordance with plans and profiles relating to said improvement on file in the office of the city clerk. The cost and expenses of said improvement shall be assessed per front foot on the lots and lands abutting thereon. Said assessments shall be payable in ten annual installments and bonds shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of such assessment and the city clerk is hereby instructed to cause this resolution to be published for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper published and of general circulation in the Corporation. and J M Stacy city Marshal is hereby appointed to serve notice of the passage of this resolution upon the owners of property abutting on said improvement who are residents of Stark County Ohio 1)
