

Albion Ohio Sept 15 1890

Council met in regular session with President Hull in the chair and the following members present. Brinker Bush, Cowan, Grubbaugh, Hartzell, Kynett, Kiplinger, Wilson. Absent Early and Seft. Minutes of preceding meetings read and approved.

A communication from Robt Learmonth asking for the opening of Petersen street from Park street to Union Avenue was read and on motion of Brinker was referred to street committee.

Wilson offered the following resolution.

Whereas it has pleased our Heavenly Father to take out of the world our worthy colleague David McLaughlin and suddenly and unexpectedly caused a vacancy in our ranks and a great sorrow like the weight of a calamity to fall upon our hearts yet bowing in submission to this dispensation of his providence "Remembering that he doeth all things well. Therefore be it Resolved -

That in the death of Councilman McLaughlin the city has lost one of its most faithful and efficient servants. The council a judicious and reliable member and left a vacancy in its ranks that can scarcely be filled.

Resolved. That our relations with him in discharge of his official duties have been most pleasant.

That his social and manly qualities were such that to know him was to esteem and love him, and that we will cherish his memory and believe ourselves the better of our associations with him.

Resolved. That we tender to his wife and children our sincere sympathy in this the hour of their great bereavement and can only, in this supreme sorrow, point them to Him whom the husband and father believed in his life time and trusted for comfort and consolation and who said I am the resurrection and the life whosoever believeth in me shall not die eternally.

Resolved That these resolutions be placed on the minutes and a copy of the same be

presented to the family of the deceased.  
Resolved, That the city Council, Mayor  
Marshal and Police force of the city wear  
a plain badge of Mourning adjusted in the  
usual way for thirty days in token to some  
extent of our great sorrow.

same. resulting yeas 9 nays none.

carried.

More Hydrants

Be it resolved that it is the sense of this  
Council that it is necessary and the Water  
Works Company are hereby instructed to  
place or have placed, five fire plugs as  
follows. One on Oxford Street west of  
Arch. One on Summit Street West of Arch  
Two on Seneca Street South of Broadway  
One in the first ward as the Council  
of that ward may direct. Provided  
that no rental for these Plugs shall  
become due within one year, and that  
the pipe on Seneca Street shall extend  
South to Summit Street.

Hartzell seconded the Motion to  
adopt the yeas and nays were

called resulting yeas Brinker Bush Cowan  
Croubough. Harzell Kiplinger. Wilson  
Nays Tynett & Hull Yeas 7 nays 2  
and the motion was declared carried.
