

Council Chamber Minutes O Oct 6th / 1890

Council met in regular session with President Hull presiding and the following members present. Brinker Bush Leonan Lombough Hartzell Kymett Keplinger. Love Siefert Wilson Absent Earley.

The Clerk being absent, president Hull called Vice president Wilson to the Chair and on motion of Brinker seconded by Hartzell Hull was elected Clerk Pro Tem.

On Motion of Brinker the reading of the Minutes of preceding meeting was dispensed with.

Hartzell moved that the sewer question on South Freedom Street be referred to the Street Committee with power to act. Carried. Yeas

Bush Leonan Lombough Hartzell Love Siefert Wilson Kymett Hull Nays Brinker Keplinger Yeas 9 nays 2.

The report of the cemetery trustees for the quarter ending Sept 30 1890 showing balance in treasury \$1496.29 was read. and on Motion of Bush accepted and ordered placed on file.

On Motion of Brinker the solicitor was instructed to prepare an Ordinance providing for the purchase of additional land for cemetery purposes and examine title to the same.

The report of Mayor Stillwell showing fines and licenses collected in September \$68⁹⁵ was read and on Motion of Bush the same was accepted.

The matter of repairing South Arch Street was on Motion Hartzell seconded by Siefert referred to the Street Committee with power to act.

Also the repairing of Penn Street 6th ward and North Union Avenue on Motion of Brinker referred to Street Committee with Power to act.

On Motion of Bush the Engineer was instructed to set grade stakes for Chambers. Funk and Courts on west side of Freedom st. Yeas 11 nays 0
