

Alliance Ohio October 20 1890

Council met in regular session with Vice President Wilson presiding and the following Members present. Brinker. Bush Cowan Orubaugh Hartzell Keplinger Lone Defert. ~~The~~ Minutes of preceding meetings read and approved.

Brinker Moved that the Clerk be instructed to prepare assessment sheets for the Streets now being improved and a reasonable compensation be allowed for the same. Seconded by Bush and Carried Yeas 9 Nays none.

On Motion of Brinker seconded by Hartzell the Engineer was instructed to furnish the Clerk with list of property and frontage of the same on the Streets now being improved. Yeas 9 Nays none.

On Motion of Bush seconded by Lone the Street Committee was instructed to have the Catch Basin at the intersection of Arch and Rosenberry Streets cleaned out and the pavement at the intersection of Summit and Arch Streets repaired also the curbing at the corner of Grant and Arch Streets repaired. Yeas 9 Nays none.

Mr Hull arrived at this time. On Motion of Brinker seconded by Keplinger the Engineer was instructed to set grade stakes for sidewalk for L. L. Lamforn at Lot 187 E Teeters Add. Corner Main and Park Streets. Yeas 10 Nays none.

The Committee to whom was referred the question of Lights on Market Street reported in favor of placing two Electric Lights on said Street. and on Motion.

Hartzell seconded by Brinker the report was adopted Yeas 10 Nays none.

Brinker Moved that said lights be placed at the Alley Crossings instead of Street Crossings seconded by Bush and Carried. Bush moved that one of the said lights be placed at the

Brinker Moved the rules be suspended and
the Ordinance be read second time by
title. Seconded by Love and Carried.

Yeas 10 Nays none. The Ordinance was
read second time by title and Bush
Moved the rules be suspended and the
Ordinance be read third time and be
placed on its final passage. Seconded
by Brinker and Carried. Yeas 10
Nays none. The Ordinance was
read third time and the Yeas and
Nays called on the final passage resulting

Yeas. Brinker Bush Cowan
Crawbaugh Keplinger Hartzell
Love Seferit Hull Wilson. Yeas 10 Nays none
and the Ordinance was declared passed.

On Motion of Hull seconded
by Brinker the Sidewalk Committee
was instructed to have the Large tree
in front of Amos Ailes corner of
Seneca and Market Streets removed
