Hilson offered the following resolution and moved its adoption. Resolved by the council of the city of Alliance that a sidewalk of brick or flag stone be constructed on the east side of Union Avenue at the intersection of Rosenberg Street with said Union Avenue to wit: Lot no 1 Grants addition lot no 34 and Lots 22 & 23 beginning at Lot no 1 (one) Grants Addition and thence north to the north boundary line of lot 23.?"

Brinker seconded the motion to adopt. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Brinker Bush Cowan Crumbaugh Keplinger Love Nilson Hull. Yeas 7 nays 0 and the resolution was declared adopted.

Brinker reported that Citizens on Market Street west of Arch. desired an electric light placed on said Market Street. and Bush stated that one was also wanted at the intersection of Liberty and Miller Streets and on Motion of Brinker the same was referred to the Light committee.

Bush moved that the matter of sending a committee to examine the manner of doing Brick paving in other cities be taken up.

(A resolution providing for the same having been adopted May 26th 1890 and the vote on the same reconsidered on June 2nd 1890)

The Yeas and Nays were called on the adoption of the original resolution resulting. Yeas Brinker Bush Cowan Nilson Hull. Nays Crumbaugh Keplinger Love Defert. Yeas 5 nays 4 and the resolution was declared lost
