A Resolution entitled "A resolution to accept bid of, and contract with W. W. Gilson for the improvement of Market Street" was read, as follows.

Resolved by the council of the city of Alliance Ohio that the bid of W. W. Gilson for the improvement of Market Street from Liberty Street to Arch Street be accepted, the same being the lowest in the aggregate for said work and the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said W. W. Gilson with George Jakes as his security for doing said work according to the plans and

specifications therefor at the following rates to wit:

Bush moved the adoption of the resolution, seconded by Keplinger and carried. Yeas. Brinker Bush Cowan Cornbaugh. Earley Keplinger Kynett. Love Wilson Hall. Yeas 10 nays none.

A Resolution entitled

"A Resolution to accept bid and contract with Robert Learmonth for the improvement of West Main Street." Was read as follows

Resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance Ohio that the bid of Robert Learmonth for the improvement of West Main Street from the west side of Union Avenue to the east curb of the Rockhill road. be accepted, the same being the lowest bid in the aggregate for said work, and the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the said Robert Learmonth with E. H. Brosius and Barclay Brosius as his sureties for doing said work according to the plans and specifications therefor at the following rates to wit:

Earth excavation and preparing sub grade per cubic yard	30 ^c
Furnishing and laying 4 inch socket tile per lined foot	10 ^c
Ballast or slag and gravel foundation per cubic yard	9 ^{7c}
Amount of bond required of contractor	\$ 3000 ⁰⁰

Moved by Wilson seconded by Keplinger the above resolution be adopted carried. Yeas Brinker Bush Cowan Cornbaugh Earley Keplinger Kynett Love. Wilson Hall. Yeas 10 nays none

On motion of Wilson seconded by Keplinger Mr Wilson was given until July 1st 1890 to complete the Paving of Market Street.

Limit of time to complete contracts on Main, State & Market st.

On Motion of Brinker Seconded by Leowan. Mr Leowan was given until July 1st 1891 to complete the work of Macadamizing West Main Street.

And on Motion of Wilson Seconded by Bush Mr Macaulay was given until June 1st 1891 to complete the Macadamizing of State Street.

Passage of Bills Ordinance

A number of bills against the city having been approved by the finance committee were read, and an ordinance ordered prepared providing for their payment. The ordinance being prepared Brinker moved the passage of the same seconded by Love. after some discussion as to the propriety of paying certain bills in full at this time. The yeas and nays were called on the passage of the ordinance resulting Yeas Brinker Leowan Crubaugh Keplinger Love Wilson Hull. Nays Bush Earley. Kynett Yeas 7 nays 3. and the ordinance was declared passed.

Thomas Crockett assessments

In the matter of the case of Thomas Crockett asking that the assessments on his lot on Liberty Street, having been returned to the Auditor be reduced to one fourth of the valuation of said lot. Brinker moved that the clerk get instructions from the Solicitor as to what to do in the matter and act in accordance therewith, seconded by Bush, and carried.

Engineer to prepare ordinance to grade Union Ave

On Motion of Brinker seconded by Wilson the engineer was instructed to prepare a grade ordinance for North Union Avenue.

Sidewalk resolution

A resolution requiring the owner of lot no 422 T L & Co's add to construct a sidewalk in front of said lot of Brick or stone within thirty days after legal notice of the

passage of this resolution was offered by Bush who moved the adoption of the same, seconded by Brinker and carried. Yeas Brinker Bush Cowan Crubaugh Earley Keplinger Kynett Love Wilson Hull. Yeas 10 nays none.

Wilson reported that the Village of Marlboro desired to purchase some of the unused gasoline lamps owned by the city and on Motion of Brinker seconded by Bush the matter was referred to the light committee with power to act.

In the Matter of Numbering the houses of the city preparatory to securing free delivery, after the selection of a certain style of number to be used from samples exhibited, Bush moved the same be referred to the city engineer with instructions to proceed with the numbering at once, seconded by Love and carried. Yeas 10 nays none.

On Motion of Earley the Marshal was instructed to notify the Street Commissioner to do no more work on streets without instructions from the Street Committee.

On Motion of Bush seconded by Love the matter of designating and naming the streets in connection with the numbering of houses was referred to the Engineer and Judiciary Committee with power to act. Yeas 10 nays none.

Bush offered the following resolution and moved its adoption. Be it resolved by the council of the city of Alliance that city engineer and Judiciary committee be instructed to prepare an ordinance regulating the height of frame buildings on Main Street from Union Depot to L.E. & S.R.R.

Love seconded the motion to adopt. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas 10 nays none and the resolution was declared adopted.

No further business council adjourned.
