 was referred the matter of sign boards to  
 designate streets, reported that they had  
 given the contract for the same to Severance  
 and Lamott at 13cts per board. for stencil  
 letters, and that said Severance and Lamott

 to the sample presented by Mr Frank  
 Keplinger
