Council met in regular session with President Hull in the chair and the following members present Brinker Bush. Leubaugh. Keplinger Love Wilson. Minutes of preceding meetings read and approved.

Mayor's report

The Mayor's report for the month of November reporting the amount collected for fines and Licenses to be \$34.00 was read and on motion of Brinker the same was accepted and ordered placed on file.

Petition for light in 1st ward

A Petition from residents of the first ward asking for an electric light at the intersection of Park and Prospect Street was read and on motion of Bush referred to the Light committee.

Shaffer and Wilson to have estimate on brick

Brinker reported that Mr Shaffer and Mr Wilson desired to get the brick on Market and Main streets. That they might be able to go to work when the weather would permit and. Moved that they be allowed an estimate of 75 per cent of the net cost of the brick when the same were delivered and a report of the same given by the citizens committee and engineer. seconded by Wilson and carried Yeas 7 Nays none.

sidewalk resolution

Bush offered a resolution and moved the adoption of the same requiring the owner of Lot no 466 T L + Co's Add. to construct a sidewalk in front of said lot. (Constructed of flag stone or brick) within 30 days after legal notice of the passage of the same. seconded by Love and carried Yeas 7 nays none.

resolution to change name of streets

Bush offered the following resolution and moved its adoption. Be it resolved that it is the sense of this council that the city solicitor be instructed to prepare an ordinance for the purpose of changing the name of Mahoning street or County line to Washington Avenue also Willow Street to Lantz Avenue. seconded by Brinker and carried Yeas 7 nays none.
