Passage of

Ordinance

The claims ordinance providing for the payment of the bills read, having been prepared was read and on motion of Bush placed on its passage. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas 10 nays none and the ordinance was declared passed.

On Motion of Brinker the Clerk was instructed to notify property owners on Main Street between Union Avenue and Mechanic Street and on Oxford Street between Morgan and Seneca Streets to pay the first installment of Assessment on or before Feb 1st 1891.

On Motion of Brinker seconded by Keplinger the Clerk was instructed to notify the Treasurer to furnish an additional bond sufficient to cover amount of money on hands at all times.

On motion of Brinker seconded by Love
the matter was referred to the Judiciary
Committee to report at next ^{meeting}.

An Ordinance Entitled "to
amend the grade on Union Avenue"
was read first time, and on motion of
Brinker seconded by Keplinger the rules
were suspended and the ordinance ^{ordered} read
second time by title yeas 10 nays none.
The ordinance was read second time by
title. Bush moved the rules be
suspended and the ordinance be read
third time and be placed on its final
passage. Carried yeas 10 nays none.
The ordinance was read third time
and the yeas and nays called on the
final passage of the same resulting
yeas 10 nays none, and the ordinance
was declared duly passed.

Brinker offered the following resolution
and moved its adoption.

Resolved by the council of the city of
Alliance Ohio that it is to the best interest
and general welfare of the city that the city
clerk give to the city his entire time and
attention to office of city clerk and that
the city solicitor be instructed to draft
an ordinance fixing the salary of the
city clerk at Fifty dollars (\$50⁰⁰) per
month payable monthly seconded by Bush
and carried yeas 10 nays none.
