

Alliance Jan 19. 1891

Council convened in regular session with president Hull presiding and the following members present. Brinker, Bush, Embaugh, Keplinger, Earley, Love, Wilson. Absent Cowan, Kynett, Seft & Hartzell.

Minutes of preceeding meeting read and approved.

Brinker offered the following resolution and moved its adoption.

Resolution to require treasurer increase bond

Resolved by the council of the city of Alliance Ohio that the city treasurer be required to increase the amount of his bond to Forty thousand dollars (\$40000<sup>00</sup>) and that the city clerk be instructed to serve a copy of this resolution on the city treasurer. Wilson seconded the motion to adopt. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas 8 nays none.
