Bush submitted sketch of towers for drying hose, and Brinker moved that the committee having in charge the building of said towers prepare plans and specifications for the same and secure bids.

On Motion of Brinker seconded by Keplinger the engineer was instructed to furnish the clerk with the number of lots and the frontage on Seneca Patterson and North Webb Streets.
