

Council Chamber Alliance Ohio April 13<sup>th</sup> 1891

Council met in adjourned session with president Hull in the chair and the following Members present. Brinker Bush Crubaugh Earley Keplinger. Love Wilson.

Minutes of preceding meetings read and approved.

Petition to extend water mains on Patterson st

A Petition from property owners on Patterson Street, asking for the extension of the water main east to the east line of L. J. Rickards property and the location of a fire hydrant at that point, was presented, and on motion of Love referred to the water committee.

and on Motion of Brinker, seconded by Wilson the same was accepted and ordered placed on file.

Mayors report

The report of the Mayor for the Year ending March 31<sup>st</sup> 1891 was read Showing fines and Licenses collected for the year amounting to \$450.90. Number of arrests made during the year for violations of city ordinance 193. on Motion of Love seconded by Brinker the report was accepted and ordered placed on file.

Petition to open Summit Street

A Petition from residents of Summit Street, between Seneca Street and the east corporate line asking that that portion of Summit Street between the points mentioned be opened up

for public travel was presented and on motion of Wilson referred to the Street committee with instructions to report an estimated cost of the same.

reading of bills  
A number of bills against the city having been approved by the finance committee were read.

apportionment of money  
Brinker moved that there be apportioned from the unapportioned fund to the street and sanitary fund the sum of \$21<sup>90</sup> seconded by Wilson and carried.

passage of claims ordinance  
Brinker moved that the bills just read be placed in the claims ordinance providing for their payment and the ordinance placed on its passage. Secended by Bush and carried. The ordinance being prepared was read, and the vote called on the passage of the same resulting yeas Brinker, Bush, Cornbaugh, Earley, Keplinger, Love, Wilson, Hull, yeas 8, nays none, and the ordinance was declared passed.

engineer set stakes for Culp  
On motion of Love seconded by Brinker the engineer was instructed to set grade stakes for sidewalk for Thomas Culp on Linden Avenue. yeas 8 nays none.

Berlin  
On Motion of Brinker seconded by Wilson Engineer was instructed to set grade stakes for sidewalk for Sol Berlin on Union Ave. yeas 8 nays none.

Temple  
On Motion of Bush seconded by Keplinger Engineer was instructed to set grade stakes for Dr Temple on Liberty Street and for H. M. Cantine corner Union Ave and Main Street. yeas 8 nays none.

Mickersham  
On Motion of Brinker seconded by Bush the engineer was instructed to set grade stakes for sidewalk for Jos Mickersham corner of Park and Columbia Streets. yeas 8 nays none.

Bush offered the following resolution and moved its adoption.

motion to adopt. The yeas and nays were  
called resulting yeas. Brinker Bush Crumbay

yeas & nays none. and the resolution was  
declared adopted.

On motion of Brinker the Street Committee  
was instructed to have Catch Basin on Arch  
street at the intersection of section line Alley  
put in at once. yeas & nays none

Auld's add

Bush presented a plat of a  
proposed addition to the city by Mr Auld  
and on motion of Brinker the same was  
referred to the Street Committee

Petition

The committee to whom was  
referred the petition to improve Arch  
Street from ~~Sumner~~ to State Street  
reported that the petition was defective  
in that it did not agree to an assessment  
as required by law. and recommended that  
the same be amended. so as to specify  
just what the petitioners would agree  
to do.

Petition for

On Motion of Brinker the report was  
accepted. and an motion of Love  
the petition was referred back to  
the petitioners to be amended.
