

Council Chamber Alliance O April 27, 1891

Council met in Special Session upon the following call of the Mayor
 "You are hereby notified that a special meeting of the Alliance City Council is called to meet on Monday evening April 27 at 7 o'clock P.M. for the purpose of appointing committees for the coming year, considering petitions and take action in regard to filling the vacancy in the office of City Solicitor, and to consider the matter of voting on the question of issuing Sewer and Street improvement bonds".

and Sewer committee.
