Minutes of preceding meetings read and approved.

Mayor's report

The Mayor's report for the month of April reporting fines and licenses to the amount of \$35.82 collected was read and on motion of Brinker the same was accepted and ordered placed on file.

A communication from W. H. Feil treasurer, appointing W. H. Ramsey, as assistant, was presented, and on motion of Jenkins was referred to the Judiciary committee.

A list of 144 names of citizens from which to select jurors in cases for the violation of City Ordinances for the ensuing year was presented to Council and on motion of Brinker the same were approved.

A Resolution ^{was} submitted to the Council by the Central Union Telephone Co. in which said Co. agrees to furnish free telephone service for fire dept and make reduction of 25% ~~on~~ from regular rates on all other telephones used by the City. Love moved the adoption of the same. Seconded by Kaylor and lost. Ayes 9 yeas 0.

A Resolution to enter into a contract with W. H. Gilson for the improvement of Seneca street was read as follows: "Be it resolved by the council of the city of Alliance Ohio that the bid of W. H. Gilson for the improvement of Seneca street from the south side of Main street to the south side of ~~Seneca~~ Summit street be accepted the same being the lowest in the aggregate for said work and that the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the said W. H. Gilson with T. B. Kulp as surety for doing said work according to the plans and specifications therefor at the following rates to wit:

Love moved the adoption of the resolution seconded by Brinker and carried. Yeas Brinker, Cowan, Corubough, Devine, Jenkins, Kaylor, Keplinger, Love, Wilson. Yeas 9 nays 0.

A Resolution to contract with Learmonth & Brosius for the improvement of North Webb street was read as follows: "Be it resolved by the council of the city of Alliance Ohio that the bid of Learmonth & Brosius for the improvement of North Webb street

On Motion of Brinker the contractors for the Webb Street improvement were instructed to proceed to work on the same at once.

The Claims Ordinance being prepared Brinker moved the same be placed on its passage seconded by Love and carried. The Ordinance was read and the yeas and nays called on the passage resulting Yeas Brinker Cowan Orubaugh Devine Jenkins Kaylor Keplinger Love Wilson Yeas 9 nays 0 and the Ordinance was declared passed.

Mayor Stillwell presented the name of Geo. R. Gyger to Council for the office of City Civil Engineer. Devine moved the same be confirmed seconded by Brinker and carried. Yeas Brinker Cowan Orubaugh Devine Jenkins Kaylor Keplinger Love Wilson Yeas 9 nays none.

There being vacancies in the Board of Health in 3^d and 4th wards. Love nominated J. K. Allen and Jenkins nominated Thomas Jarman. and on motions being seconded by Brinker they were confirmed.

On Motion of Brinker. Mr ^{contractor} Hadley was instructed to proceed to work on Patterson street improvement.

The Water Committee to whom was referred the petition for the extension of the water main on South Arch Street. reported in favor of granting the request of the petitioners and recommended the same. Love moved the report be adopted and that the Water Works company be instructed to have the main laid in accordance therewith. seconded by Jenkins and carried Yeas Brinker Cowan Orubaugh Devine Jenkins Kaylor Keplinger Love Wilson Yeas 9 nays none.

No further business Council adjourned
