Do the County's share of placing sewers across Patterson and Webb Streets seconded by Bush and carried. President Wilson appointed as said committee Messrs Devine Bush and Brinker.

Bush moved that the water works company be instructed to extend water main South on Seneca Street to Grant street and place a Hydrant at the North west corner of Seneca and Grant streets. Seconded by Love. Brinker moved to amend by including the pipe and Hydrant petitioned for on East Peterson Street, and all other pipes and Hydrants

at present ordered. The same to be put in in the rotation in which they were ordered. Seconded by Kaylor. The yeas and nays were called on the motion to amend, resulting Yeas Brinker Cowan Crubaugh Devine Earley Keplinger Nilson Stays Bush Jenkins Kaylor Love Yeas 7 nays 4. The motion to amend was declared carried and the yeas and nays called on the original motion as amended, resulting yeas Brinker Cowan Crubaugh Devine Earley Keplinger Nilson Stays Bush Jenkins Kaylor Love. Yeas 7 nays 4, and the motion was declared carried.

On Motion of Devine the offer of the independent Hook and Ladder company tendering their services to the city was accepted they to be under the control of the chief of the fire Dept.

On Motion of Brinker the Buildings and Grounds committee were instructed to have the Mayor's office painted and papered, and to have the necessary repairs made on the city prison and fire department building in the second ward. Yeas 11 nays 0.

A Resolution to contract with John Hadley for the improvement of Patterson Street was read as follows:

Be it resolved by the council of the city of Alliance that the bid of John Hadley for the improvement of Patterson Street from the east side of the C. & N. R. R. East to the east corporation line, be accepted, the same being the lowest in the aggregate for said work, and that the Mayor be authorized to enter into a contract with the said John Hadley with M. C. Barber and H. H. Brown, as sureties for doing said work according to the plans and specifications therefor at the following rates to wit:

Said assessments shall be payable in ten annual installments and bonds shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of such assessments. and the City Clerk is hereby instructed to cause this resolution to be published for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper published and of general circulation in the corporation and F. W. Stacy is hereby appointed to serve notice of the passage of this resolution upon the owners of property abutting on said improvement who are residents of Stark county.
