Kaylor called attention to the condition of the city's lot back of City Hall, and suggested that the same be cleaned up and all stone and rubbish be removed and some places be furnished to hitch horses, and moved the same be referred to the committee on buildings

An Ordinance entitled an Ordinance to improve South Arch street from Milner to State Street was read first time, moved by Brinker and seconded by Jenkins the rules be suspended and the ordinance be read second time by title. the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Brinker Bush Crubaugh Jenkins Kaylor Keplinger Love Wilson. Nays Drove Carley. yeas 8 nays 2, and the motion was declared lost the necessary  $\frac{3}{4}$  not voting in the affirmative.

Ordinance  
to issue

purposes

An Ordinance entitled an Ordinance to authorize the Mayor and Clerk to issue the bonds of the city for the purpose of providing a fund for the construction of sidewalks was read first time, and on Motion of Brinker seconded by Bush the rules were suspended and the ordinance ordered read second time by title, by the following vote Yeas: Brinker Bush Crubaugh Drove Carley Jenkins Kaylor Keplinger Love Wilson. yeas 10 nays none. The ordinance was read second time by title, and Brinker moved the rules be suspended and the ordinance be read third time and be placed on its final passage, seconded by Bush and carried Yeas Brinker Bush Crubaugh Drove Carley Jenkins Kaylor Keplinger Love Wilson. yeas 10 nays none

The ordinance was read third time and the yeas and nays called on the final passage, resulting yeas Brinker Bush Combaugh Devine Earley Jenkins Kaylor Keplinger Love Wilson Yeas 10 nays 0, and the ordinance was declared Passed.

consideration on Patterson street resolution

Bush moved that the <sup>vote on the</sup> resolution to improve Patterson street be reconsidered seconded by Kaylor and carried, yeas Brinker Bush Combaugh Jenkins Kaylor Keplinger Love Wilson Nays Devine Earley, yeas 8 nays 2. On motion of Brinker the resolution was laid on the table until the report of the committee on the petition to change the grade on Patterson street.

The Grade committee to whom had been referred the said Petition reported as follows:

Report of grade committee on Patterson street grade

"We the grade committee recommend that the prayer of the petition be granted, and we further recommend that the bridge at Trails run be raised about ten inches and that the engineer be instructed to prepare an ordinance to comply with this change."

reading of ordinance on Patterson street

The ordinance to amend the grade on Patterson street was then read 1st time.

amending report of grade committee on Patterson street

Brinker moved to amend the report of the committee by striking out that part that recommended the raising the bridge at Trails run. The yeas and nays were called, resulting yeas Brinker Bush Combaugh Earley Jenkins Wilson Nays Devine Kaylor Keplinger Love.

The motion to amend was declared carried and the yeas and nays called on the adoption of the report as amended, resulting yeas Brinker Bush Combaugh Earley Jenkins Kaylor Keplinger Wilson Nays Devine Love yeas 8 nays 2, and the report as amended was declared adopted.

Bush moved that the ordinance to amend grade on Patterson street be read second time pending a suspension

of the rules. The yeas and nays were called on the motion to suspend rules resulting Yeas Brinker Bush Crumbaugh Earley Jenkins Love Wilson Mays Devine Kaylor Keplinger. Yeas 7 nays 3. and the motion was declared lost.
