A Petition from residents of North Liberty Street, asking for Council to provide sewerage to carry off storm water that damages their property was presented ~~and~~ <sup>and</sup> on motion of Bush was referred to the grade and sewer committee and on motion of Lane the finance committee was instructed devise means for procuring the necessary funds to put in a permanent sewer along said street connecting with the sewer crossing Patterson Street at that point and on motion Devine the matter of making temporary repairs on the sidewalks on said North Liberty street recently washed out by heavy rains was referred to the sidewalk committee with power to act.

Be it resolved by the city council of the City of Alliance Ohio that the Central Union Telephone Company now in possession of and operating the telephone exchange in this city be requested to furnish for city use with exchange service one free telephone at the office of the Mayor in the city building one free telephone at the residence of the City Marshal one free telephone at some suitable place in the sixth ward in said city - also such other telephones for city use as the city Council by resolution may require and at twenty five per cent discount from the regular

rates. from time to time charged for business purposes. provided that separate contracts containing the customary provisions shall be previously executed in the name of the city by the proper officer having endorsed thereon the terms of payment herein specified.

Resolved further that said company be requested to file a written acceptance of this resolution in the office of the city clerk.

and be it further resolved that the resolution passed June 12<sup>th</sup> 1891 relating to telephone service be and the same is hereby repealed. Taylor seconded the motion to adopt. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas 10 nays 0 and the resolution was declared adopted.

Bush offered the following resolution and moved its adoption.

Whereas an addition to the city known as ~~Alliance~~ Lantz's Addition lying east of the C & P R.R. is being rapidly built up as is also Peters, Lamborn & Co's add. with no crossing between Broadway and Grant Streets.
