

Council Chamber, Alliance O. July 13<sup>th</sup> 1891

Council met in adjourned session with President Wilson in the Chair and the following members present. Brinker Bush Crubbaugh Earley Jenkins Kaylor Love. Brinker offered the following resolution and moved its adoption.

Resolution to

Be it resolved by the council of the city of Alliance Ohio. That the street committee be instructed to notify the Street Commissioner to perform no more labor on the streets of the city unless authorized by resolution of Council.

and that the city clerk be instructed to serve the street commissioner with a copy of this resolution. Love seconded the motion to adopt. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Brinker Bush Crubbaugh Kaylor Love Wilson. Nay Jenkins. Yeas 6 nays one. and the motion was declared lost.

Attention was called to the fact of certain parties throwing waste paper and refuse of all kind into the streets in certain portions of the city particularly on the street immediately north of Main street and between Freedom and ~~Summit~~<sup>Seneca</sup> streets and on motion of Brinker the same was referred to the Judiciary Committee.

An Ordinance to amend the grade on South Liberty Street was read the first time and Bush moved the rules be suspended and the ordinance be read second time by title, seconded by Brinker and carried Yeas 9 nays 0. The Ordinance was then read second time by title.
